Eligibility requirements and pricing guidelines.

Of the 55 Heron Manor apartments, 25 one bedroom apartments are reserved for low-income individuals, age 55 or older who require assistance with two or more Activities of Daily Living from the list below:

- eating
- toileting
- bathing

- grooming mobility
- dressina
- transferring

medication management


Applicants must also have a Person Centered Plan of Care established by a service agency and sufficient means of paying for the prescribed care. Acceptable payment includes the following programs: Department of Human Services Home Help (DHS), Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE), and Medicaid MI Choice Waiver. See attached sheet for information on applying for the MI Choice Waiver.

 22 apartments have project-based Section 8 vouchers through the Grand Rapids Housing Commission. Rental rates are based on income. The maximum annual income for an individual is \$22,100, and \$25,250 for a two person household. The attached Preliminary Housing Application is required to be submitted to the Housing Commission to be on the waiting list for these apartments. An Application for Heron Manor Apartments is also required prior to consideration, but does not result in waiting list placement.

- Preference for at least 13 of these 22 apartments will be given to referred individuals transferring out of nursing homes through the Nursing Facility Transition Initiative.
- 2 apartments have reduced rent of \$582 per month for qualified applicants earning under 50% of area median income. The maximum annual income for an individual is \$22,100 and \$25,250 for a 2 person household.
- 1 apartment has reduced rent of \$663 per month for qualified applicants earning under 60% of area media income. The maximum annual income for an individual is \$26,520 and \$30,300 for a 2 person household.

An Application for Heron Manor Apartments is required. A \$600 Security Deposit is required at move-in.
